








Taking into account all of the artifacts (objects) throughout your home, we want you to **collect a mixture of items** that **share some common theme** of your choosing. This can be applied to all kinds of content, such as coins, pictures, toy cars and dolls. Remember to **choose the items YOU find most interesting** to showcase in your exhibition.

Once you have decided on a theme, and which items to showcase, we want you to **provide a written commentary** about each item in your collection. This will aid visitors to your exhibition in **understanding the significance** of each piece.



**Top Tip!** Research each artifact on the internet, or in books you may already own – or have borrowed – to include additional information and interesting facts.
