

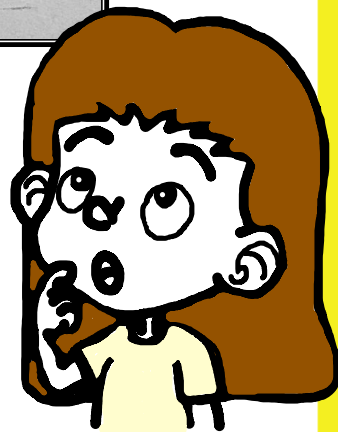
DISCOVERY DAY AT HOME

DISCOVERY DAY AT HOME

Taking into account all of the artifacts (objects) throughout your home, we want you to **collect a mixture of items** that share some **common theme** of your choosing. This can be applied to all kinds of content, such as coins, pictures, toy cars and dolls. Remember to **choose the items YOU find most interesting** to showcase in your exhibition.

Once you have decided on a theme, and which items to showcase, we want you to **provide a written commentary** about each item in your collection. This will aid visitors to your exhibition in understanding the **significance** of each piece.

Example: I have chosen to create a Natural History Exhibit with my collection of stuffed animals. I have created museum labels for each one, identifying its name, type of animal, age, and where the stuffed animal is from.

Top Tip! Research each artifact on the internet, or in books you may already own – or have borrowed – to include additional information and interesting facts.
